Recorded at the DVLA as a "Runninwild", she was first registered on the 1st June 1997 and is recorded as 1200 cc., the last M.O.T. test expired, it seems, on the 18th July 2011. The trike is currently SORN'd and the V5C is now present. This rather unusual three-wheeled motorcycle was constructed as an R & R project on an Aircraft carrier in the Falkland Islands during the Falklands War, presumably therefore either on H.M.S. Invincible or H.M.S. Hermes. A previous owner is understood to have toured the continent with her, towing a small trailer. As can be seen, she has a Motorcycle-style front end and a VW Beetle air cooled rear end/transaxle/running gear. No engine is included with the trike, but a suitable engine should not prove too difficult to source. The trike, which has obviously been road-legal, is sold for restoration/ recommissioning and should make an exciting winter project. Registration No. LWW 239, believed to have been manufactured on the 26th August 1952, Car No. YB/0675, Engine No. XPAG/SC2/17569, Scuttle No. 478 SRZ 12592 - 125 MG 6335. The YB 1,250 cc overhead-valve petrol-engined cars had a four-speed gearbox with synchromesh on the the three upper gears. These cars, the development of which received the talented input of Alec Issigonis (famous for the designing of the Mini) were quite revolutionary at the time in having rack & pinion steering and independent front suspension with wishbones and coil springs, the independent set-up having being developed from the suspension of pre-war MG racing cars. The YB was considered an improvement on the Y(A) in having the handling sharpened-up by the installing of a front anti-roll bar and up-rated shock absorbers, the front drum brakes being of the twin leading shoe type. Inbuilt hydraulic jacking was also novel in the form the "Smiths Jackall" system, which could be selected to lift the front, the rear or indeed all four wheels off the ground. As can be seen, the car has been partially stripped for renovation and the many components were found in the passenger compartment and in the boot. There is no registration document currently to hand and the registration number is not presently recognised at the DVLA, but it may well be feasible to retain the number with the assistance of the excellent enthusiasts' clubs. Here is an ideal winter project that should prove most rewarding in returning to the road one of the only 1,301 of these sporty-handling cars that was produced, very few of which remain. The car's serial numbers are recorded on the International Y Type Register, but other relevant details are absent including its country of location, colour, ownership, condition, etc., Images of the various components present will be added shortly.
