We reserve the right to refuse entry of any item for any reason.

PAYMENT: Cheques will be posted within 10 working days after sale date. Cheques will not be issued for total net proceeds less than £5.00 and cash proceeds can be collected from our office by prior arrangement. Any cash proceeds not collected within six weeks of the sale date will be given to charity. Monies are held in Nigel Ward & Co. Clients' Account with Barclays Bank, 1/3 Broad Street, Hereford, the account is interest bearing and any interest accrued on this account is used to offset bank charges. The Auctioneers shall not be liable for payment to the vendor until such time as full payment has been received from the purchaser.

RESERVES: Vendors may place reserves upon items entered if they wish. Vendors are requested to collect any unsold items as soon as possible, otherwise removal and storage costs may be chargeable or the item may be disposed of.

WARRANTY: Nigel Ward & Co. will not guarantee the condition of any items unless a vendor specifically requests them to do so. If within ten days after the sale, Nigel Ward & Co. have received from the purchaser of any lot notice in writing that in his/her view the item is a deliberate forgery, and if within seven days after such notification the buyer returns the lot to the Auctioneers in the same condition as at time of the sale and by producing evidence, (the burden of proof to be on the purchaser) satisfies the Auctioneers that considered in the light of an entry in a catalogue the lot is a deliberate forgery, then the sale of the lot will be rescinded and the purchase price of the same refunded but no compensation will be paid to the purchaser or the vendor.

CONDITIONS OF SALE: The Sale is conducted under General Conditions of Sale, copies of which are available upon request.

ELECTRICAL ITEMS: ANY FAULTY ITEMS SHOULD BE MARKED AS FAULTY ON DELIVERY. Under the Low Voltage Electrical Equipment (Safety) Regulations 1989, electrical items submitted for auction must either be sold as tested by a suitably qualified electrician or sold as scrap and clearly labelled as such with the lead removed. Genuine antique and collectors' items can be sold "for display purposes only" and the leads and plugs removed. A Qualified Electrician will test all electrical items entered prior to the auction and a charge of £2.40 incl. V.A.T. will be made for each item, this being deductible from the sale proceeds.

UPHOLSTERED ITEMS: Under the Furniture and Furnishings (Fire) (Safety) Regulations 1988, all second-hand furniture which is offered for sale must meet the full fire resistance requirements & must have a permanent label attached. The only exemption from these Regulations is for furniture made before 1950. We will therefore be unable to offer any upholstered furniture made after 1950 that does not have the necessary fire regulations label with batch number attached.

VEHICLES: Under the Road Traffic Act any vehicles which are to be offered for sale should be insured with at least Third-Party Insurance.

DELIVERY OF ITEMS: Please Telephone us prior to delivery of any items. All Items should be delivered to the Salerooms on either Thursday 26th or Friday 27th February between 9am and 1pm or between 2pm and 5pm. Transport and storage can be arranged, and a separate charge will be made for this service.
